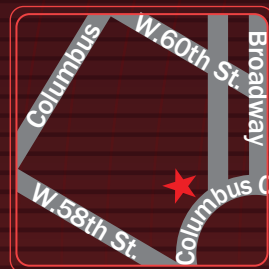

MANHATTAN CHAMBER ORCHESTRA

The Manhattan Chamber Orchestra was founded in 1987 by its artistic director and conductor, Richard Auldon Clark. Hailed by the media as an “extraordinary ensemble of virtuosos,” and credited with providing the “definitive versions of forgotten American masterpieces,” the Manhattan Chamber Orchestra has been dedicated to innovative, exciting, and multi-cultural programming. The MCO has premiered and recorded the music of such diverse composers as William Grant Still, Alec Wilder, Victor Herbert, Henry Cowell, Alan Hovhaness, Otto Luening, Randall Thompson, David Amram, and Dave Soldier. The MCO performs music of all genres with a special emphasis on contemporary American music. In addition to touring and a heavy recording schedule, the MCO is regularly heard in the New York area, and presents its “Mostly American” series at Merkin Concert Hall. The orchestra has also been featured at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Symphony Space, Weill Recital Hall, Trinity Church, and the United Nations. In 1995, the orchestra received the NAIRD “Indie” award for Best Classical Album for its CD *Mountains and Rivers Without End*. Also in 1995 the orchestra was awarded the Lincoln Center Community Arts Project Award and performed at Alice Tully Hall. The Manhattan Chamber Orchestra can be heard on the *Newport Classic*, *KOCH International*, *AVANT*, *VOX*, *Helicon*, *KLEOS Classics*, *Mulatta Records*, and *Keuka Classical* labels.
